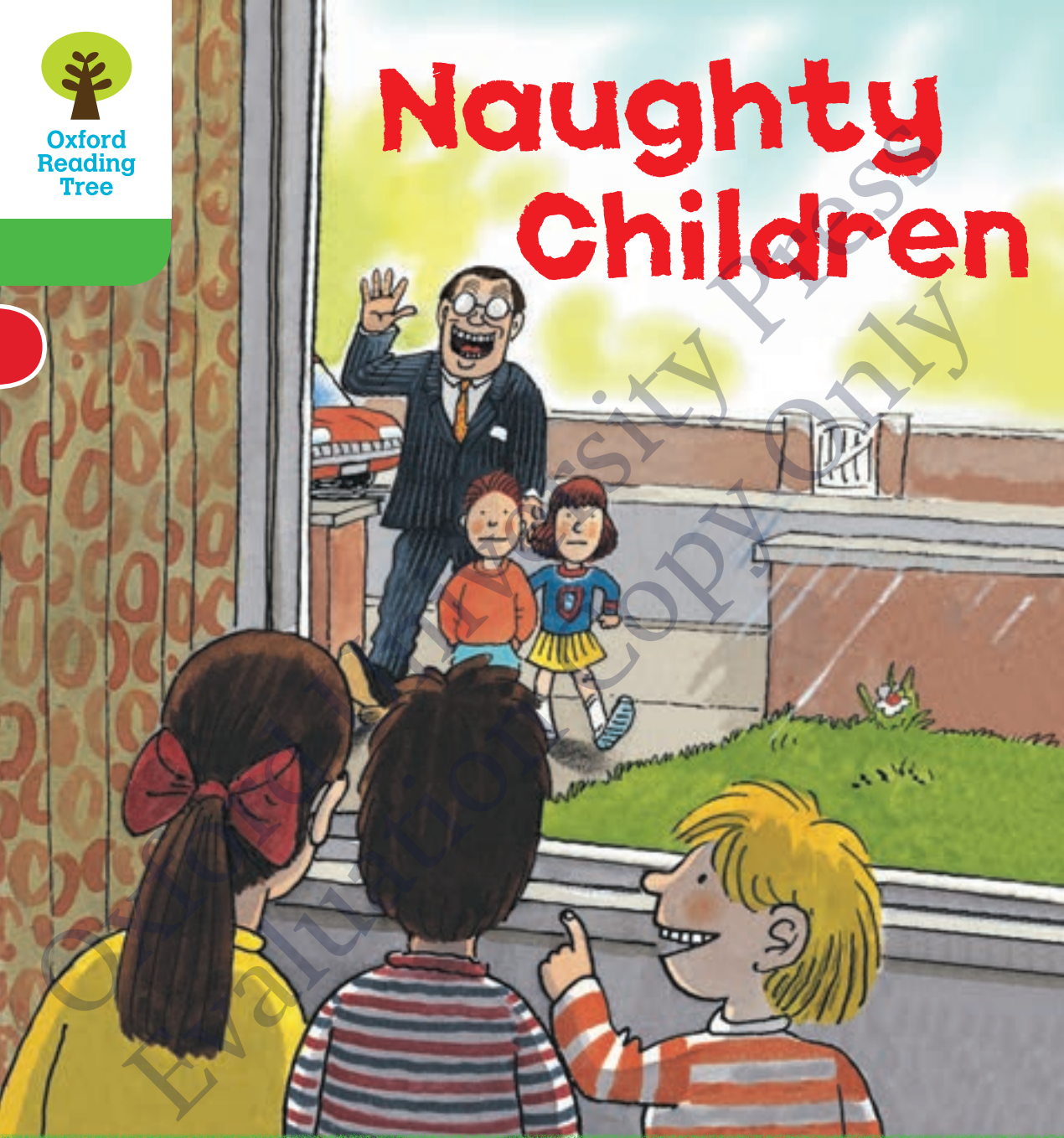


Naughty Children

BEFORE READING

Talk together

- Read the title and look at the children arriving with their dad. Ask: *What do you think might happen?*
- Talk about the last time your child invited a friend home to play.
- Look through the book and talk about the pictures.

About the words in this book

- Your child should be able to sound out and blend some words, which may include:

**on up bed Mum had
an off log net**

- Some words may be more challenging. Encourage or model blending, then read the words below to your child if necessary.

**was they two children
climbed furniture
jumped sofa
curtains flowers
idea ladder
wall happy**



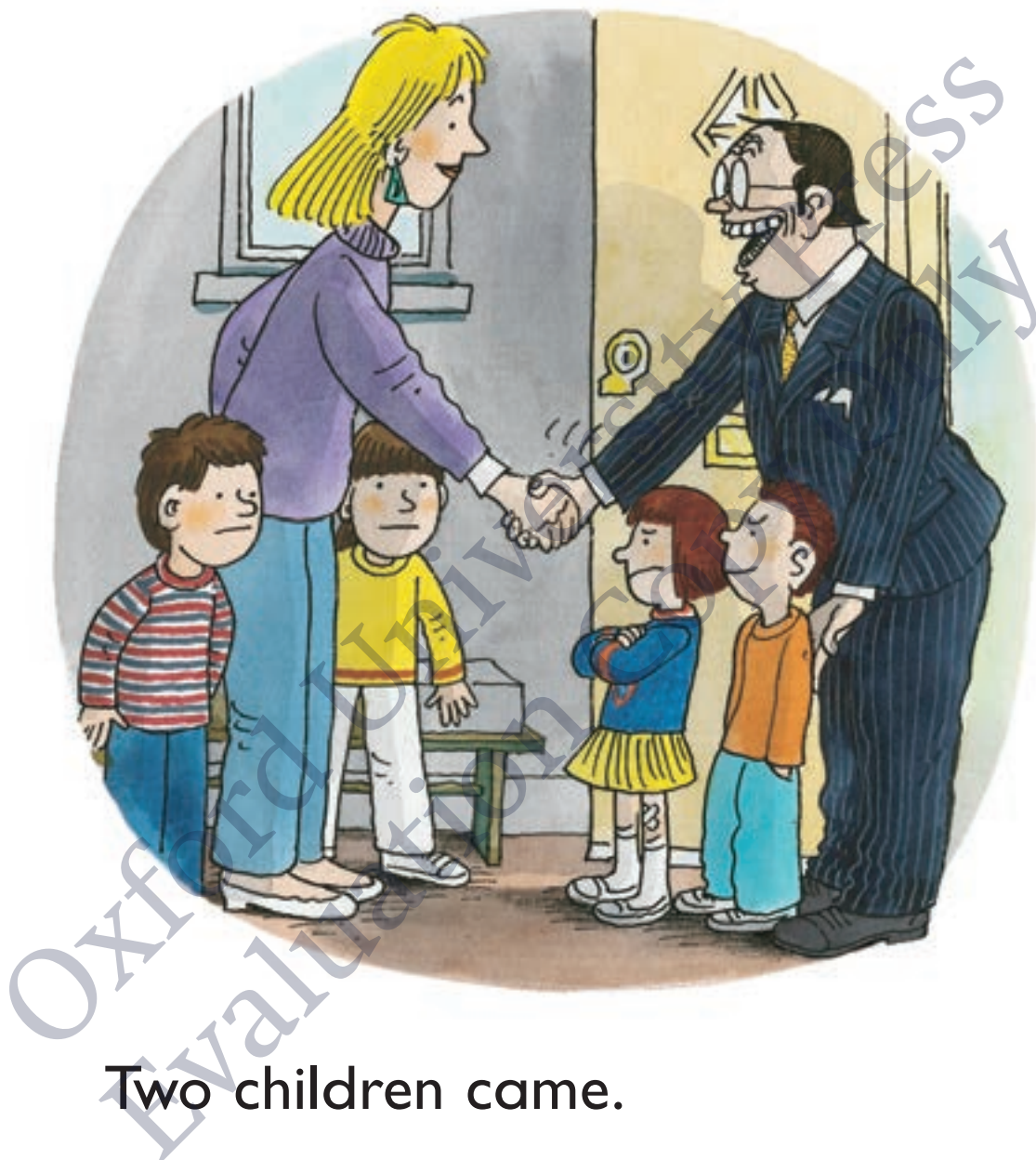
DURING READING

Enjoy the story together.
If your child needs support to read the words:

- Ask your child to point from left to right under each word whilst reading.
- Model how to sound out and blend new words if necessary.
- If a word is still too tricky, simply say the whole word for your child.
- Use the pictures to talk about the story and learn the meaning of new words.

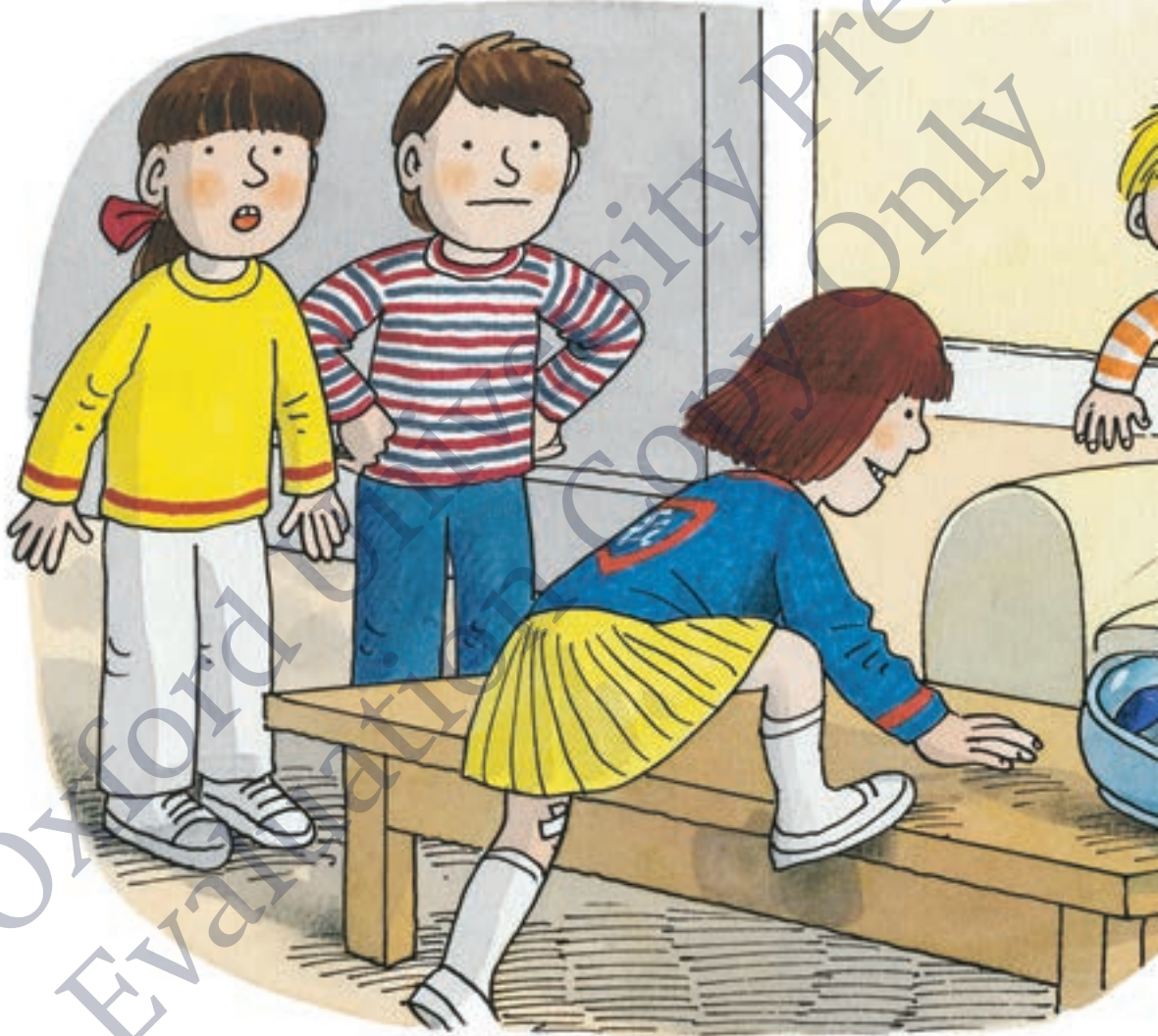
