### BEFORE READING Talk together

- Some words may be more challenging.
   Encourage or model blending, then read the words below to your child if necessary.


### **DURING READING**

- Use the pictures to talk about the story and learn the meaning of new words.




"Oh no!" said Anna.
"My glasses!"




"I cannot find them," said Kipper.




Anna was upset.




"Get out of the ball pit!" said Kipper.




They all got out.




"I cannot find them," said the man.




"We must get the balls out," the man said.




They put the balls in a big net.
