## BEFORE READING Talk together

- Look at the cover and read the title together. Ask: What is Dad doing?
- Talk about what wet paint feels like.
- Look through the book and talk about the pictures.

 Your child should be able to sound out and blend some words, which may include:

 Some words may be more challenging.
 Encourage or model blending, then read the words below to your child if necessary.

### **DURING READING**

Enjoy the story together. If your child needs support to read the story:

- Remind your child to sound out and blend unfamiliar words from left to right.
- Look for compound words, where two words create a bigger word, e.g. moonlight.
- If a word is still too tricky, simply say the whole word for your child.
- Re-read sentences to focus on their meaning where necessary.


Dad was painting the back door.

Floppy wanted to come in.




He jumped up. He put his paws on the paint.

Biff kicked a ball. The ball hit the door.




Dad painted the door again.




Kipper pushed the door. He got paint on his hands.



Dad was fed up.




He painted the door again. "What a job!" said Dad.
