



Grammar Rules Adverbs	
Adverbs can tell:	Examples
 how something happens. These adverbs often end in -ly. 	They <mark>walk slowly</mark> .
• where something happens.	The peach tree is north of the bench.
• when something happens.	We always visit the peach tree.
