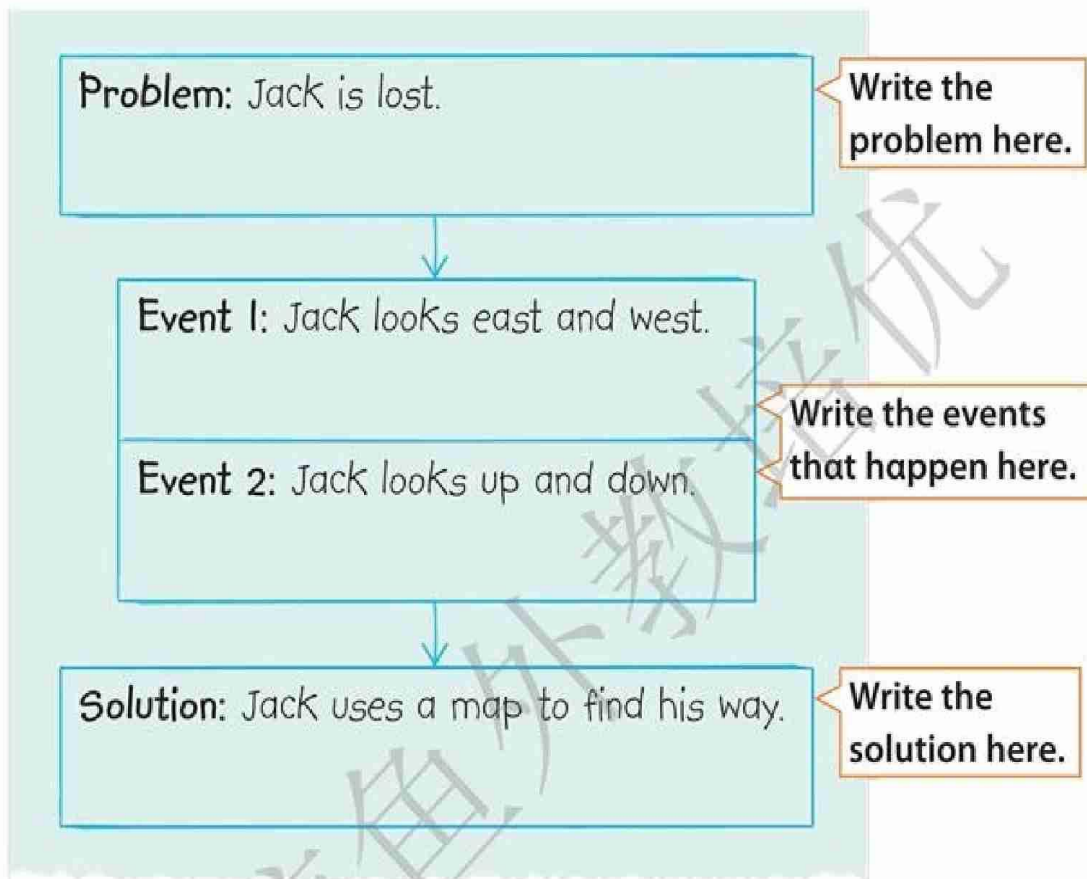


Talk Together
