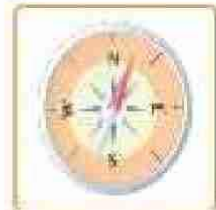

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How to Make a Compass

What You Need

sewing needle	clear container
<u>water</u>	bar magnet
plastic foam cup	<u>paper</u>
crayons	scissors

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What You Do

1. Cut out the bottom of the foam cup to get a flat circle.
2. Rub the needle the same direction on the bar magnet 20 times.
3. Lay the needle on the foam circle.
4. Put the foam and the needle in the water. The needle will stop moving when it points North.
5. Draw a compass rose and place the container with water over it.
6. Move around the paper until the needle lines up with the N on the compass rose.
