

Plural Nouns

A **noun** is a word that names a person, place, or thing. A **singular noun** shows "one." A **plural noun** shows "more than one."

	Singular	Plural
 Add -s to most nouns to show more than one. 	street job	streets
 Add -es to nouns that end in x, ch, sh, ss, z, and sometimes o. 	bench class	bench <u>es</u> class <u>es</u>
 For nouns that end in y, change y to i and then add -es. 	baby sky	babies skies


